A note for the parents.

It is very important that your child reads, but it is equally important that they enjoy reading during the holidays. It is better they read something they enjoy, than nothing at all. We have tried to choose books that we hope will give them pleasure. We want books to provide a challenge, but not too much of a challenge. When you and your child choose a book, let them read the first page: most websites let you read a page before buying, and bookshops do. We want the child to understand all the vocabulary on the page but, ideally maybe 2 or 3 words on the page are unfamiliar. Two or three new words a page will grow their vocabulary and provide a gentle level of challenge. More than 2 or 3 and the book may be too difficult and your child may become discouraged and not finish.

Audio books are great, you can all listen to them on car journeys and then you can, as a family, discuss the stories. We all know that children copy adults, if they see us reading, they will join in.
